Let us continue to move forward with confidence, clarity, and a shared commitment to excellence.

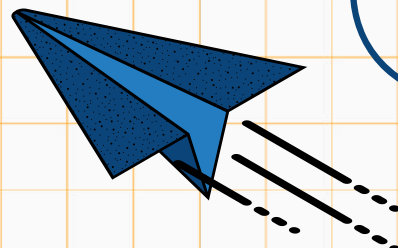
