As we move forward, the focuses are turning to effective learning and teaching and teachers' continuous professional development as we endeavour to meet our students at their point of need, so they progress in all areas of the curriculum. Sri UCSI Kuala Lumpur strongly embraces the belief that learning occurs in many different settings beyond the walls of a traditional classroom. We introduce our students to a variety of exciting, stimulating and enriching experiences. We will further encourage the growth of a global perspective in our school by integrating concepts such as international mindedness, sustainable development, 21st-century skills to better equip our students for the demands of the ever-changing world. One of the aspects of Sekolah Sri UCSI Springhill that distinguishes us from other private schools in Malaysia is our emphasis of 5 very specific cross-curricular focus points. The 5 cross-curricular focus points (are referred as the 5C's of UCSI Schools 21st Century Learning) are Creativity, Collaboration, Critical Thinking, Communication and Character.

Starting this academic session of 2023/2024, these cross-curricular focus points span across the curriculum and are emphasised in every classroom and in every lessons in stages.

- First C, Creativity, refers to the ability of students to make use of their knowledge and/or talents to create something new, or to produce something in a new way.
- Second C, Collaboration points to the way students use various personalities, talents, and knowledge to work together and produce something new.
- The third C, critical thinking, refers to the ways that students filter, analyze, and question any information that they might find in various media, be it written, spoken, or broadcast, and then synthesize it to fit their understanding.
- The next C, which stands for communication, refers to the ability to put forward ideas and information in a clear, meaningful way. Communication has four main purposes, which are to "inform, instruct, motivate, and persuade" audience. The information presented should be clear, concise, correct, and coherent, so that readers/listeners will get the intended meaning.
- The last C, character, refers to their ability to empathize with others and apply that information to their behavior. Often referred to as emotional intelligence, this C is the foundation for creating positive, meaningful relationships. In addition to academic skills, students should also possess emotional intelligence, grit, perseverance, an intrinsic desire to learn, and the capacity to empathize with others. This is obviously a process that will need to happen over years and not just class periods.

We believe that developing these characteristics in the lives of students is the real essence of education.

Sekolah Sri UCSI Kuala Lumpur will be closed for the Hari Raya & Mid-Term 1 break from 20th – 28th April. We will observe a public holiday for Labour Day on 1st May. Therefore, all classes will resume on Tuesday, 2nd May 2023.


