Thank you for your continued trust and support. We hope you enjoy this edition.

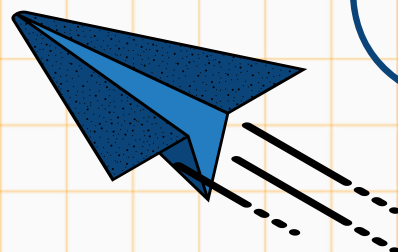

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Mastering NotebookLM

Your Private AI Researcher

adapted from the video "How To Master NotebookLM in 2026" by YouTube creator Paul J Lipsky.

NotebookLM is like ChatGPT, but it only knows the specific files you give it – no hallucinations from the wider internet. Here is a simple 3-step system to use it effectively.

1. CURATE

The AI is only as good as the sources you give it. Be selective – only upload articles, PDFs, videos, or websites you trust. You can upload from Google Drive, paste website links, or add raw text directly. Tip: if a site is behind a paywall, copy and paste the text manually.

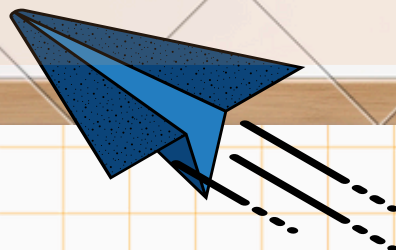
2. LEARN

Once sources are loaded, the Chat section becomes your personal expert. Use Configure Notebook to give the AI a persona (e.g. 'Act as an elite marathon coach'). Every answer comes with citations so you can verify accuracy. The Studio panel lets you generate audio overviews (AI podcasts), visual aids (mind maps, infographics, slide decks), and study tools (quizzes, flashcards).

3. ACT

Knowledge is only useful when applied. Use the chat to draft outlines, write scripts, or build plans based on your materials. Save great answers as notes and convert them into new sources for your knowledge base. Share notebooks or generated visuals with collaborators.

Key Takeaway: Stop using it like a generic search engine. Think of it as a private library where you control every single book on the shelf.



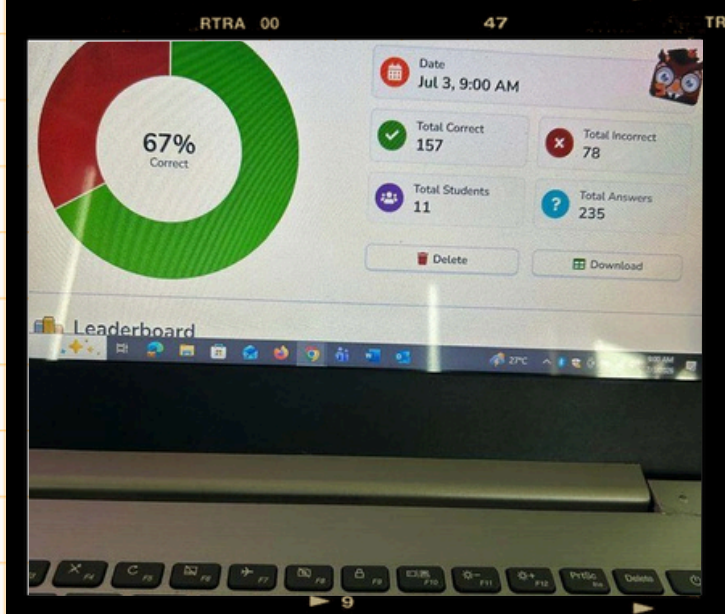
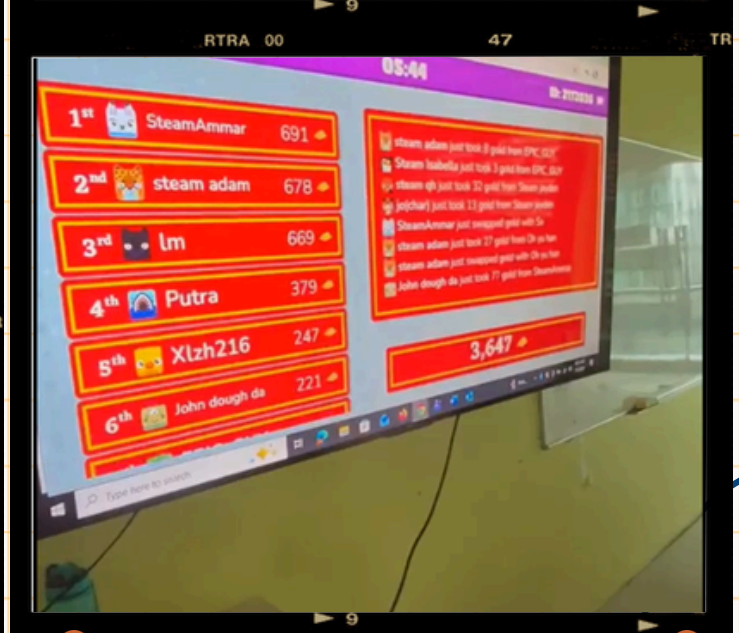


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ACADEMIC:
