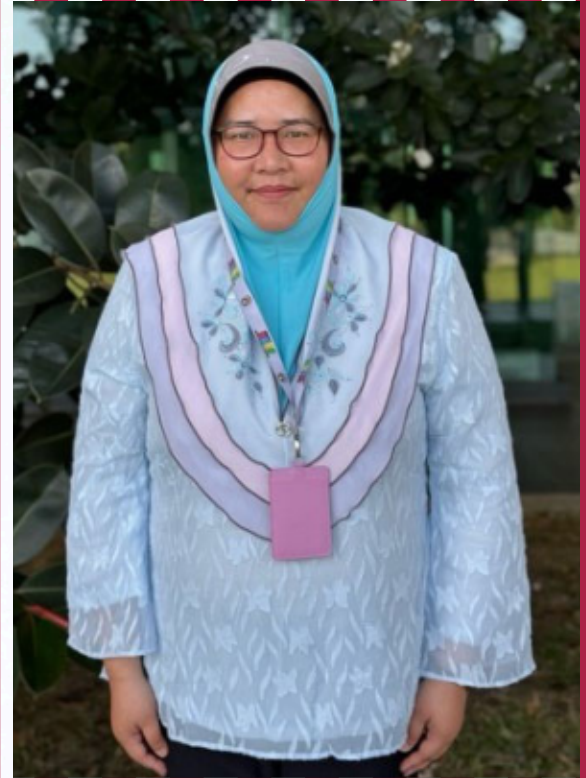

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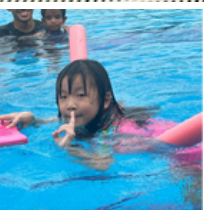

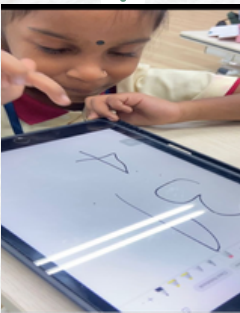
Creating the Perfect Clay Number 2

Students roll the clay into a long shape and stick it on the number 2 printed on paper. Students use their fingers to smooth out any rough edges and make sure the shape looks like the number 2. Once they completed the sticking activity, they started the practice of tracing number 2. Clay modeling is a fun and engaging activity that captures children's interest and keeps them actively involved in the learning process. It offers a playful way to explore numerical concepts while sparking curiosity and fostering a positive attitude toward learning.

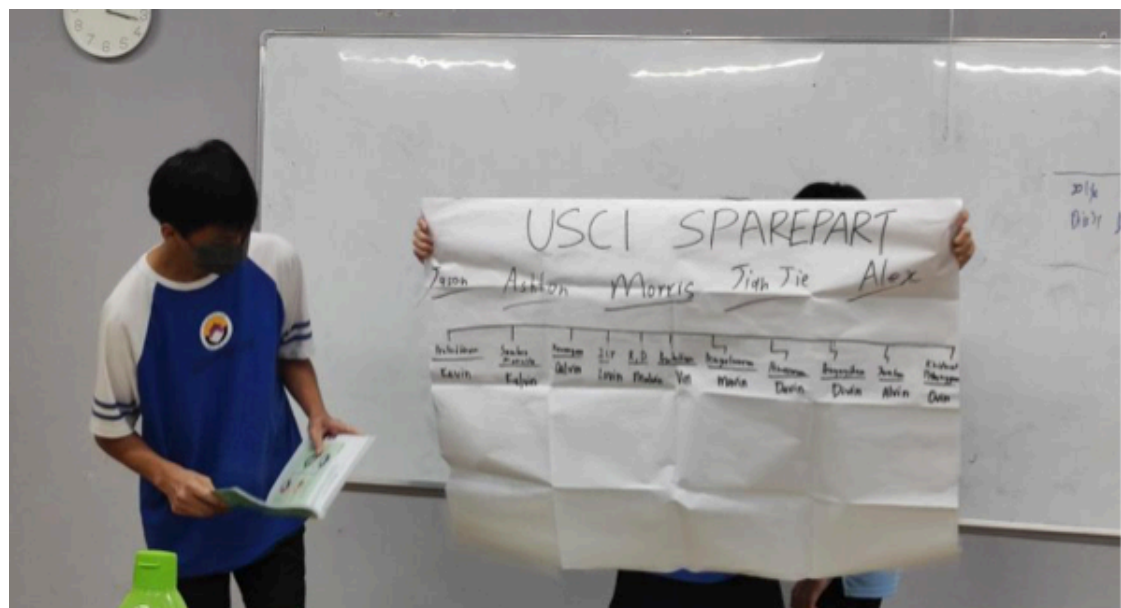
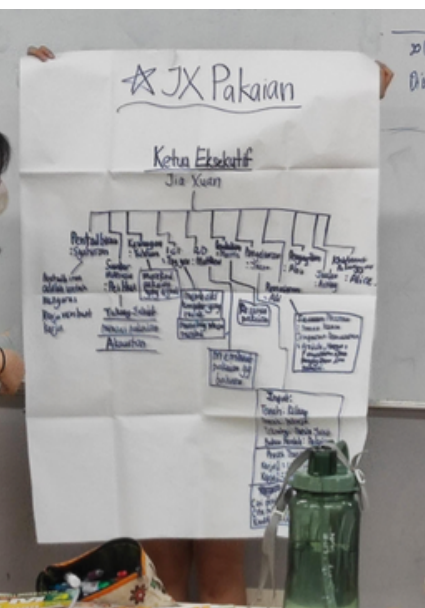
