Sekolah Sri UCSI Springhill showcased their English language skills in the prestigious Hippo "English Without Borders" Contest, an international competition that brings together young learners from around the world. This year, our school proudly participated in the preliminary rounds, before they can advance to higher levels.

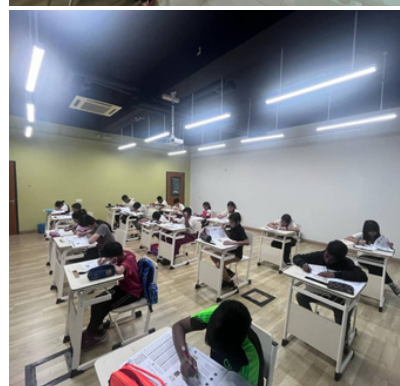


The Hippo Contest, organized by the Global Hippo Association, aims to promote English language proficiency and cultural exchange among non-native speakers aged 6 to 19. It is open to students in various categories based on age and language level, and it includes multiple rounds: preliminary, semi-final, and final stages, with the final held in Italy.

Hippo English Without Borders Contest

is an international competition that allows pupils between the ages of 6 and 19 to demonstrate their proficiency in English. The Global Hippo Association (Italy) and Gatehouse Awards (UK) have been organising it since 2013, giving competitors the opportunity to gain globally recognised credentials and advance to the World Finals in Italy. The official coordinator for Singapore and Malaysia is Caya Academy. Preliminary Round, National Finals, Qualifiers (subject to terms and conditions), and World Finals in Italy are the four stages of the competition. Those who don't make it to the World Finals can participate in the Play-Off and Regional Qualifiers. Internationally recognised and Ofqual-regulated English qualifications are used in the Hippo exams, which are in line with the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR).

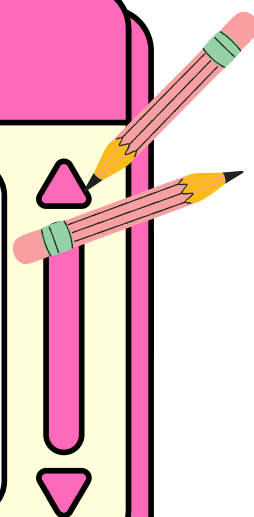
Reading, writing, speaking, listening, and the "Use of English" (which include vocabulary and grammar) are the five main components of English proficiency that are assessed by the Hippo Contest.

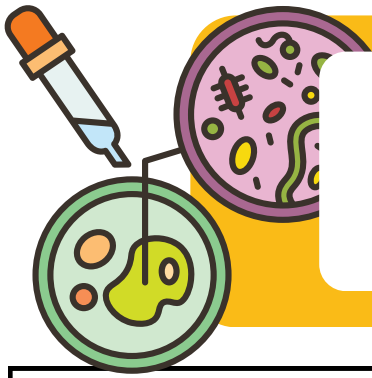
ICT: Exploring Code with Pre- Reader Express!

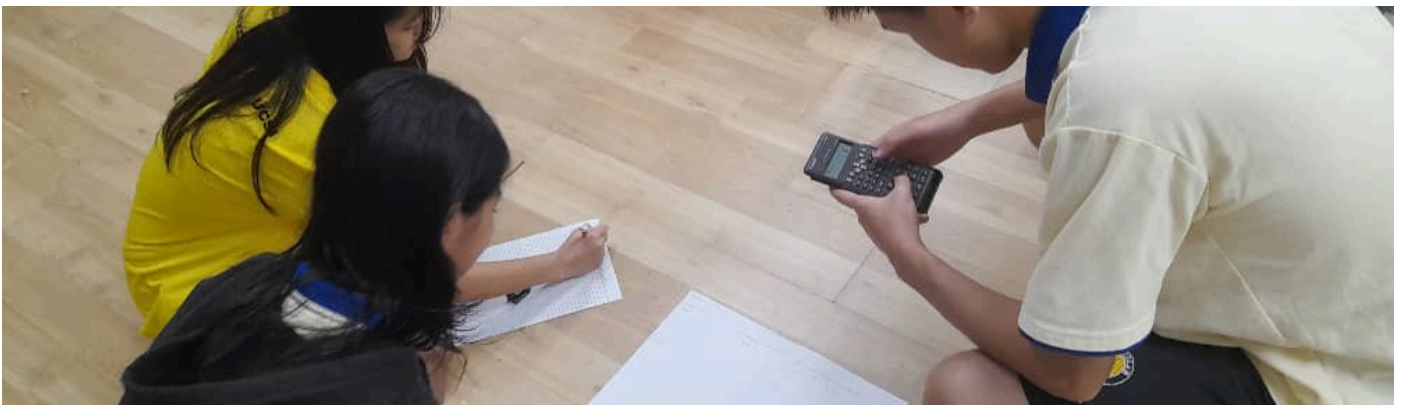
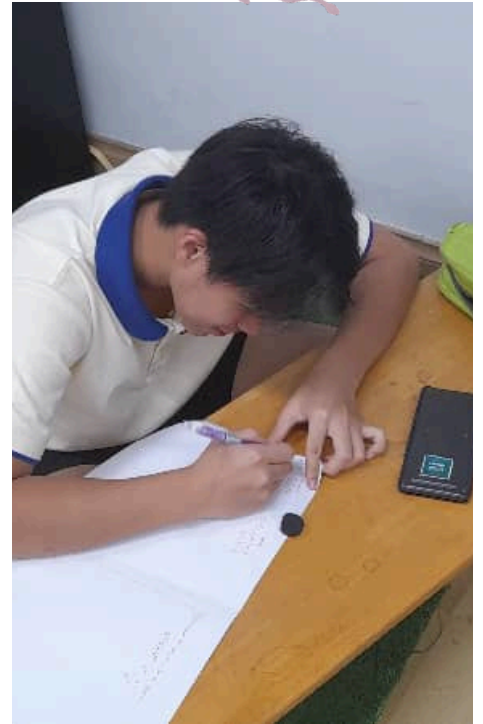
SECONDARY LEARNING ZONE



INDICES: UNDERSTANDING POWERS AND EXPONENTS

This week, our Form 3 students have been diving into the topic of indices. They have been learning about the laws of indices and applying them to simplify expressions and solve problems. Through guided explanations and practice exercises, students have been strengthening their understanding of exponent rules and their applications.

To reinforce their learning, students worked on tutorial questions in class. They tackled various types of problems, including simplifying expressions, solving equations involving indices, and understanding negative and fractional indices. We developed a group activity in which students were split up into small teams in order to promote collaborative learning.



A series of complex indices-related tasks were assigned to each group to work through together. They exchanged ideas, spoke about various strategies, and collaborated to arrive at the right answers. In addition to improving their problem-solving abilities, this exercise encouraged cooperation and communication.
