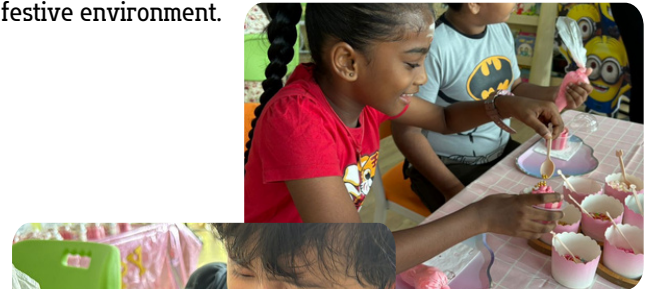
EYC OPEN DAY 2025: A JOYFUL DAY OF DISCOVERY, FUN, AND COMMUNITY SPIRIT

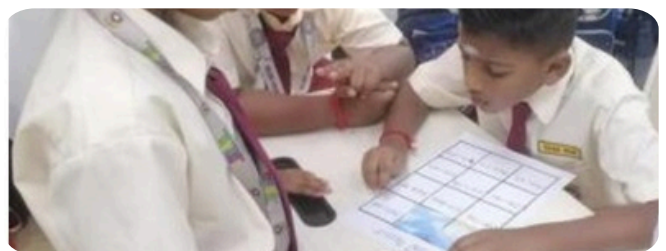

They also used colourful base ten blocks to break numbers apart and rebuild them step by step. To add extra excitement, we introduced engaging subtraction puzzle games that challenged students to solve problems and find hidden answers.

SECONDARY LEARNING ZONE

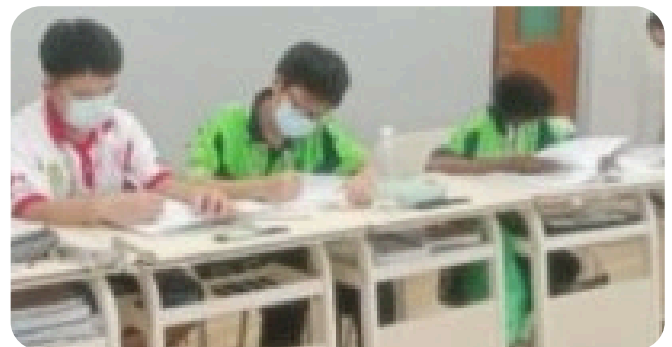
SEJARAH (FORM I)

Sejarah Form 1 lessons have taken an exciting turn with the integration of interactive quizzes and AI-generated materials to enhance student engagement and understanding.



Students explore topics such as early human civilisation, the development of kingdoms, and the heritage of the Malay world through dynamic, gamified learning. Quizzes in the style of Jeopardy, Snakes and Ladders, and BINGO Sejarah are used regularly to make learning fun, interactive, and competitive—encouraging participation from all students.

To support this, the teacher also incorporates AI-generated visuals and narrated videos into her teaching. These include animated timelines, interactive diagrams, and digital recreations of historical sites, which help students visualise concepts better and make learning more immersive.



This combination of technology and interactive tools has significantly improved student attention, retention of facts, and overall enthusiasm for the subject.



History is no longer just about memorising dates and facts—it has become a journey of discovery, exploration, and critical thinking, supported by modern tools and creativity.
