SUBJEK: BAHASA MELAYU

Subjek bahasa melayu untuk kanak-kanak 4 tahun adalah lebih berfokus kepada bermain sambil belajar. Hal ini dapat dilihat apabila kanak-kanak lebih tertarik untuk belajar sambil bermain. Kanak-kanak akan jadi lebih fokus untuk meneroka apa sahaja topik yang diajar pada hari itu. Aktiviti yang diberikan kepada kanak-kanak 4 tahun lebih cenderung ke arah mengenal huruf kecil dan huruf besar. Selain itu, aktiviti yang boleh meningkatkan motor halus kanak-kanak tersebut.

Selain itu, kanak-kanak yang berumur 5 tahun akan lebih cenderung untuk belajar topik-topik mudah seperti cuaca, kenderaan, keluarga, diri saya dan sebagainya. Pada peringkat ini, kanak-kanak akan lebih mudah untuk mengetahui perkataan-perkataan baharu dalam bahasa melayu. Perkataan mudah yang digunakan seperti dua suku kata sahaja. Kanak-kanak 5 tahun ini juga akan belajar untuk mengenal huruf dan mengeja perkataan mudah bagi menambah ilmu pengetahuan mereka di dalam bidang bahasa melayu. Akhir sekali, kanak-kanak berumur 6 tahun akan cenderung untuk belajar perkataan yang melebihi dua suku kata. Belajar untuk mengenali perkataan yang lebih rumit dan panjang. Kanak-kanak pada peringkat ini, cenderung untuk membaca ayat mudah dengan mudah dan lancar. Aktiviti yang dilakukan turut melibatkan ejaan perkataan dan berkomunikasi dengan baik. Kanak-kanak juga boleh berucap atau berkomunikasi dengan menggunakan perkataan yang mudah dengan baik.

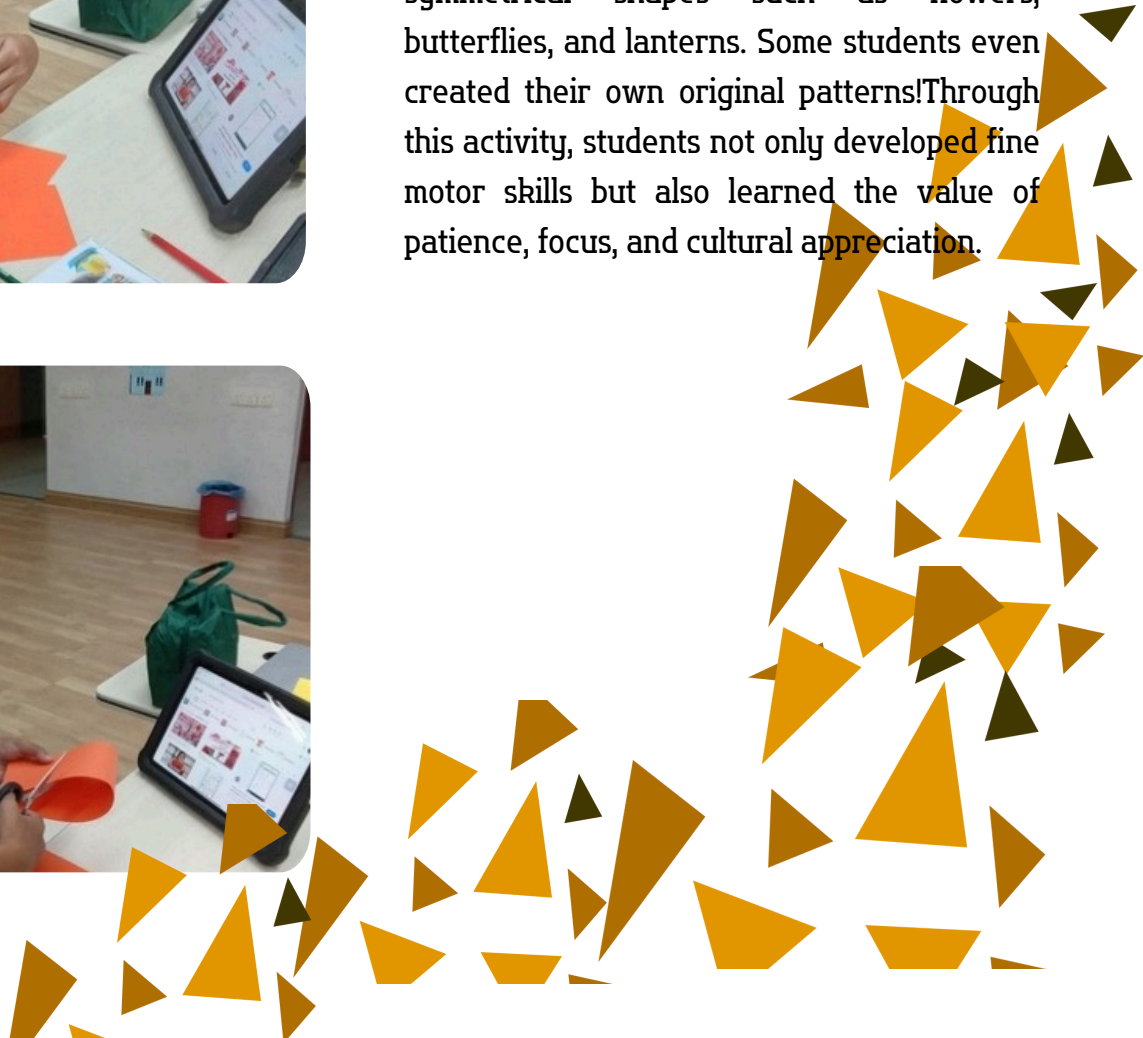
PRIMARY LEARNING ZONE
