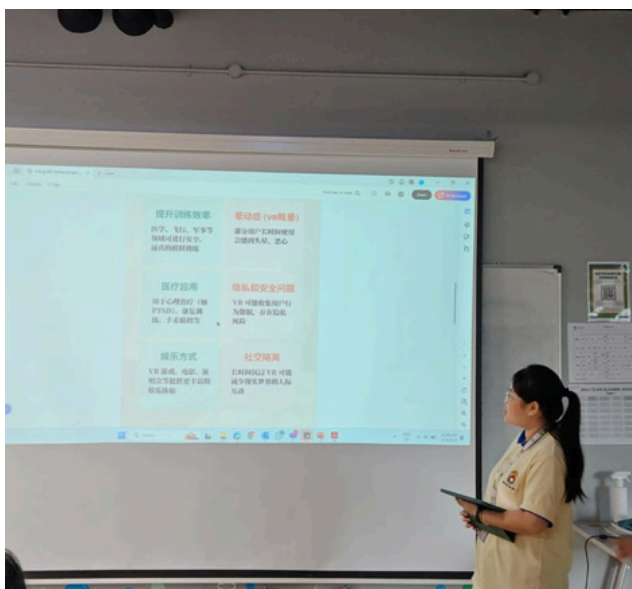


HIPPO SUMMER CAMP

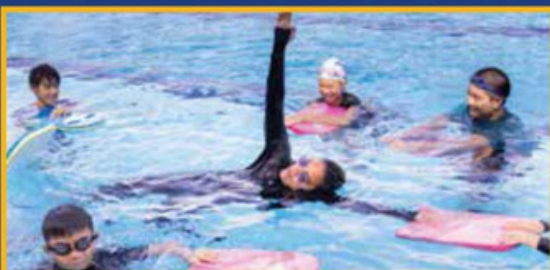
