NURSERY STUDENTS LEARN ABOUT PLANTS THROUGH DIORAMA

FORM 3 SCIENCE STUDENTS EXPLORE GREEN BUILDING DESIGN THROUGH 3D MODELLING

In an effort to promote creativity, innovation, and environmental awareness, the Form 3 Science students at UCSI Schools recently embarked on an exciting project that integrated 3D modelling technology with real-world applications of energy conservation. As part of their topic on Work, Energy and Power, students explored the concept of Green Buildings and their role in promoting sustainability and efficient energy use. Guided by teacher, students learned about the principles of sustainable architecture such as the use of renewable energy sources, natural lighting, and eco-friendly materials to minimise energy waste and reduce environmental impact.

Using Tinkercad, an online 3D design platform, students then applied these principles to design their own 3D models of green buildings. The activity provided a meaningful opportunity to integrate STEM learning combining scientific understanding, engineering design, and digital literacy.
