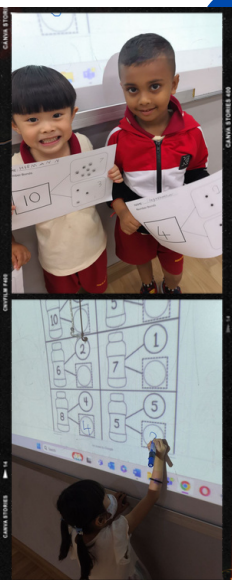
Little Chef Event

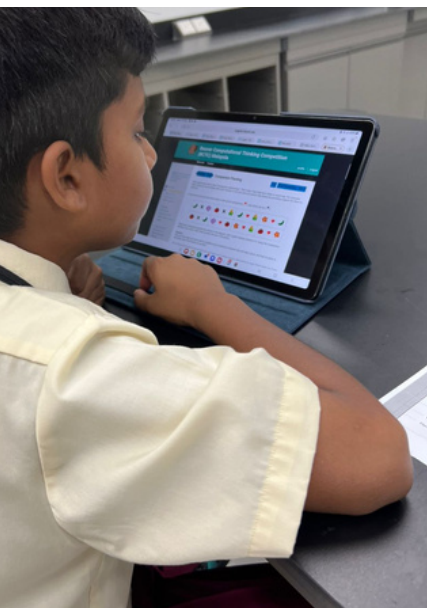
