# **Dual certification**

Sekolah Sri UCSI Subang Jaya adds depth and substance to our KSSR and KSSM curriculum by enhancing them with the Cambridge International Curriculum, mainly the Cambridge Primary and Cambridge Lower Secondary curricula.

Students in Standard 6 and Form 3 sit for the Cambridge Checkpoint exams set by Cambridge Assessment International Examinations (CAIE), providing an international benchmark for our students' achievement. IGCSE is offered to selected students only at the upper secondary.

This approach provides students with a comprehensive and well-rounded education, granting them wider access to tertiary pathways and international recognition. With dual certification, our students enjoy the flexibility to choose from a broad range of higher education institutions, both locally and abroad. Whether they decide to study in Malaysia or internationally, their qualifications empower them with the freedom to make informed and flexible decisions about their future.





The dual certification of SPM and IGCSE has given me an upper hand in applying for scholarships after graduating high school as it demonstrates a well-rounded academic foundation. Besides, knowing both ends allows me to understand concepts better in pre-university, particularly in my A-levels.

# ENGLISH MASTERY: FROM PRIMARY TO GRADUATION

This structured approach has led to outstanding results: 100% of our students pass the SPM English exam and 87% achieve distinctions. These impressive outcomes enable our graduates to confidently pursue tertiary education both locally and internationally, equipped with exceptional English language skills.





Having attended an SJK (C) school, I initially found Checkpoint English as a First Language quite challenging. However, reflecting on my experience, I realise that studying English as a First Language at the English Checkpoint Examinations significantly enhanced my language skills. Now, I feel much more confident in both spoken and and written English than I did five years ago.




# STRUCTURED PERFORMING ARTS PROGRAMME
