Chinese Interactive Learning

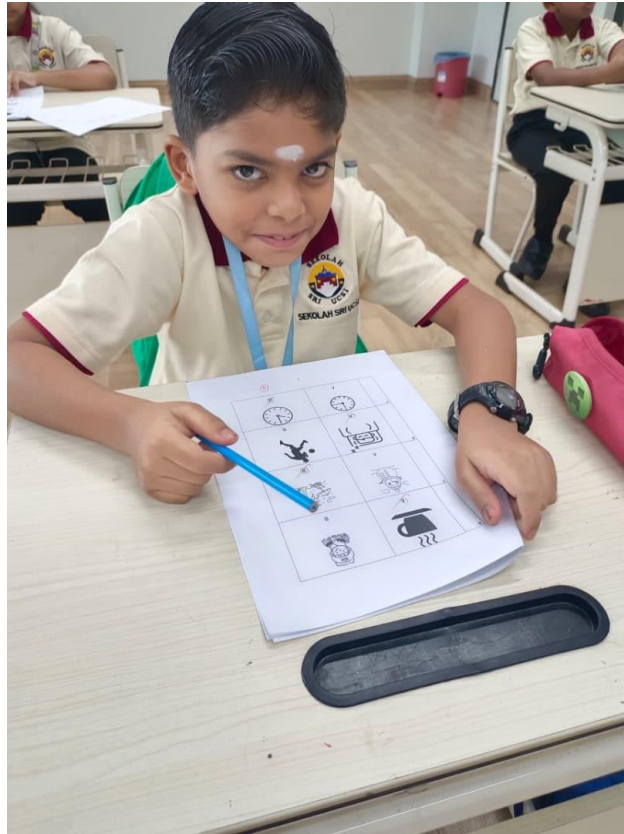


This month, our Primary 3 class has been immersed in vibrant Chinese learning activities, focusing on reading comprehension and assessment review. Our students have shown great enthusiasm and progress in both areas! Reading Chinese Texts with Confidence We've been exploring our Chinese textbooks, diving into lively lessons like "今天的天气怎么样" (How's the Weather Today?) and "今天几月几日" (What's the Date Today?).

Here is a summary of the ongoings in class:



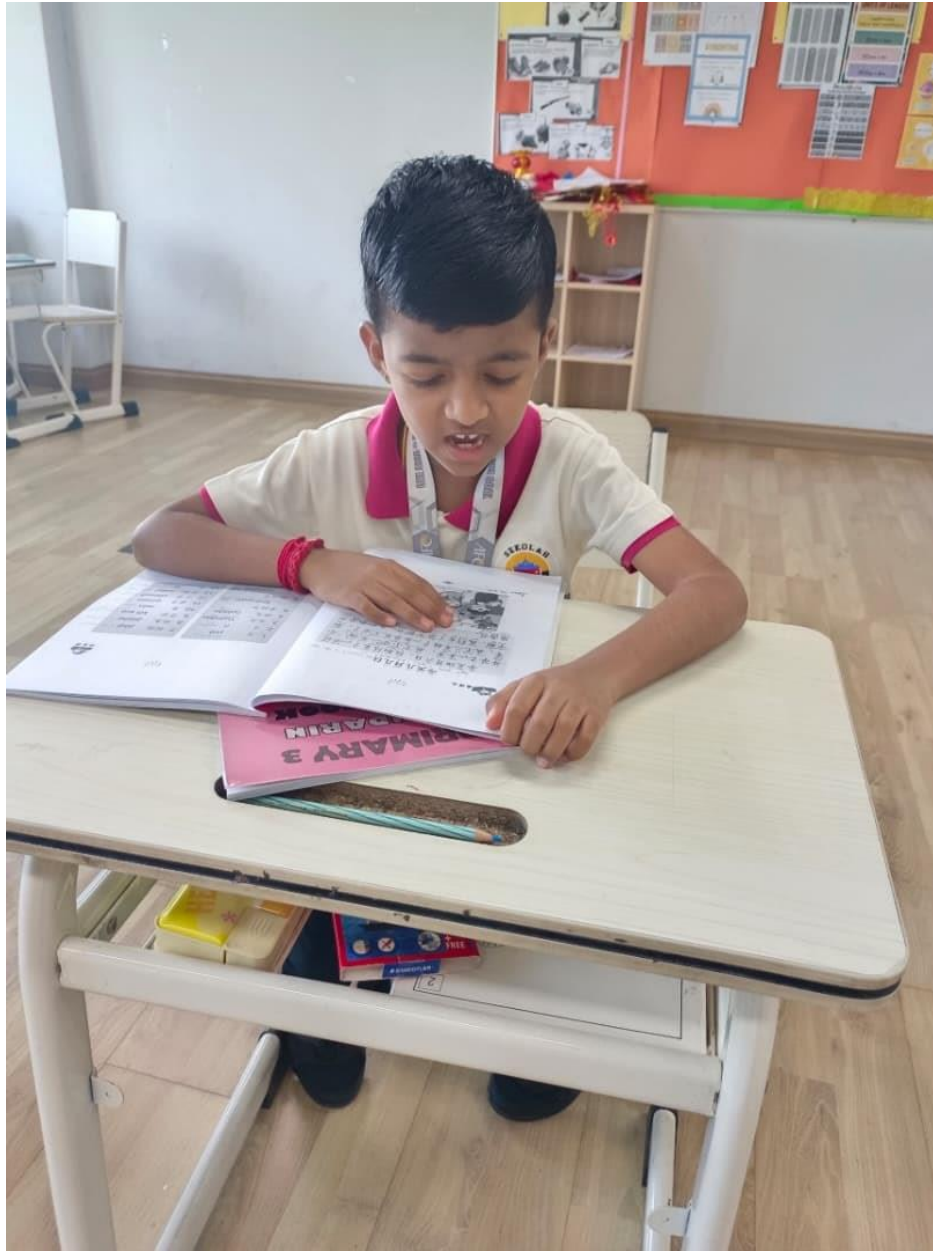
Students took part in interactive reading activities that included reading aloud, identifying key vocabulary, and understanding seasonal concepts such as spring, summer, autumn, and winter, as well as date expressions. Their learning was also supported through collaboration, with peers helping one another find words in textbooks and discuss the meaning of the stories together. In addition, many showed focused effort by working independently to read passages, answer questions, and connect the text to their own real-life experiences, helping to strengthen their foundational reading skills.



To make exam corrections more engaging, students used different coloured pens to identify errors, write corrections, and highlight key points, making the review process more visual and interactive. They also took ownership of their learning by carefully reviewing each question, whether at their desks or with the help of tablets for reference. In addition, classmates worked together to identify mistakes and support one another, creating a collaborative classroom environment.



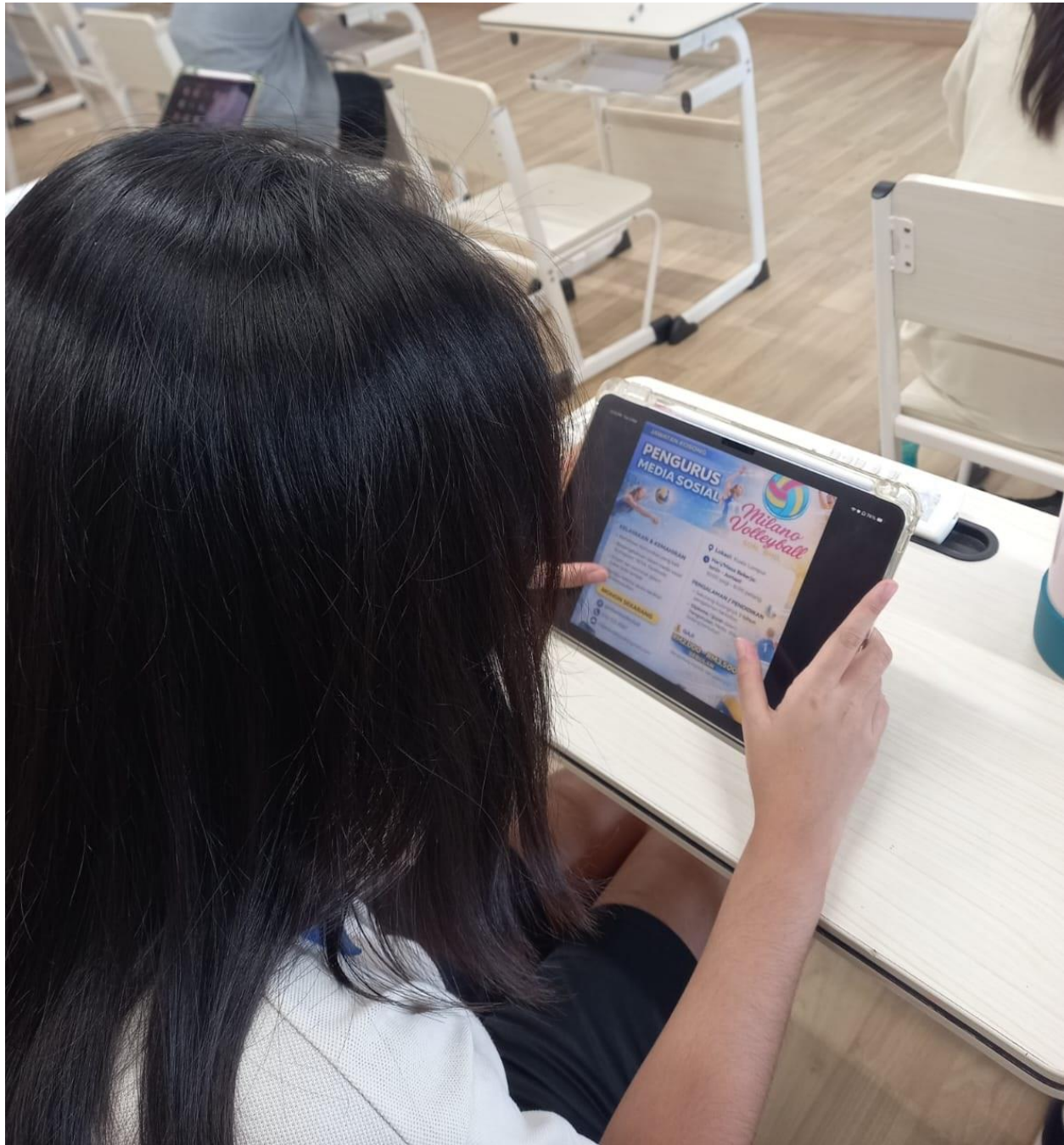
Students significantly improved in reading fluency and comprehension and they became more confident in identifying and correcting their own mistakes. They also worked well together by helping each other during class. Overall, they maintained positivity toward Chinese learning, which helped make each lesson lively and productive. Looking ahead, we will continue to build on these skills by reading a wider range of Chinese stories and dialogues, introducing creative writing activities based on the texts, and continuing to use colourful review methods to make learning engaging and effective.
