Brave Speaker English Lesson: “Vegetable Garden” Poem Recital

This term, our Primary 3 Mandarin lessons focus on guided oral reading practice, where students actively read textbooks aloud to build basic language skills. With focused classroom reading activities, every child gains confidence in recognising characters, pronouncing words correctly and understanding simple Mandarin texts.

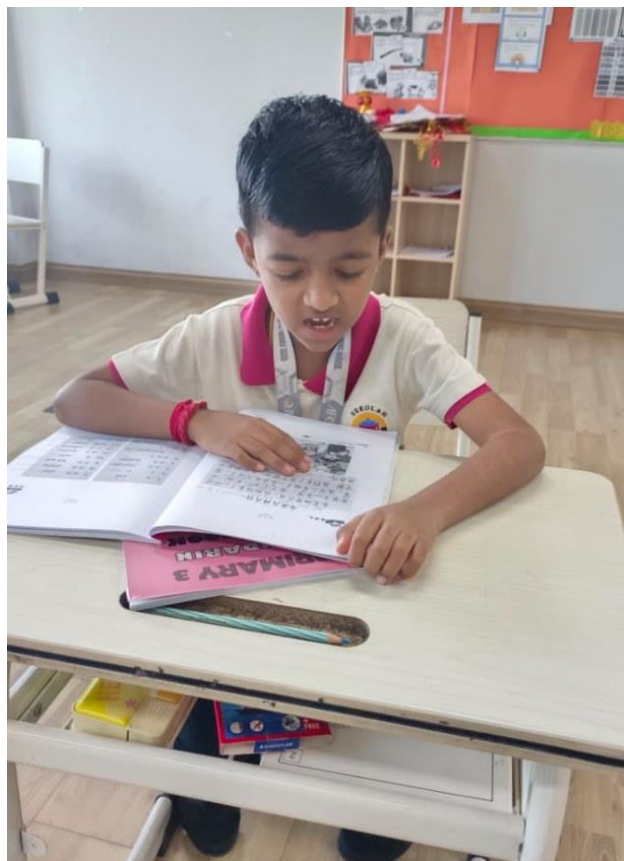
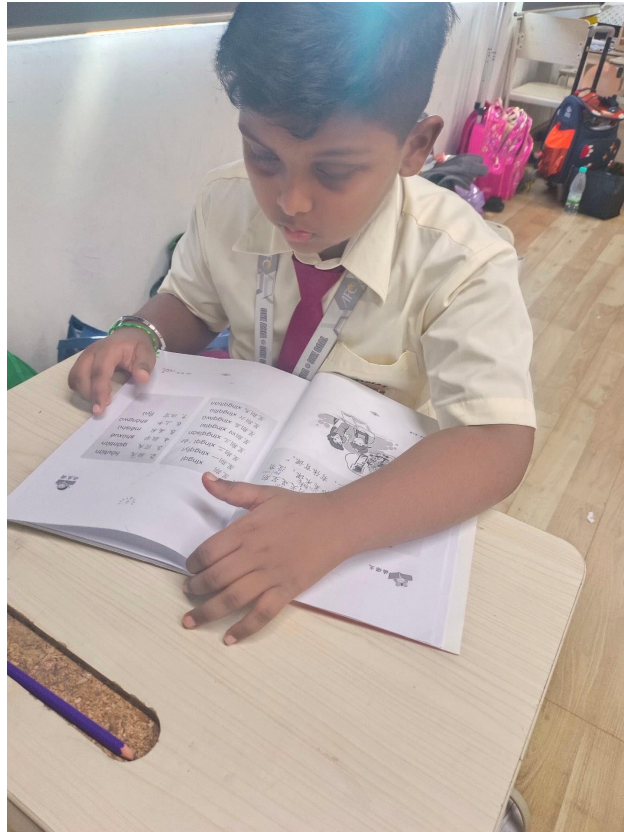
During lessons, students take turns reading Mandarin passages individually and in pairs. They point to each word while reading, carefully following textbook content about days, dates and daily conversations. This hands-on reading method helps them improve pronunciation accuracy, boost reading fluency and strengthen character recognition. Peer learning is also encouraged, as classmates listen to each other's reading and offer gentle feedback to improve together.

These reading activities bring great benefits to our young learners. Students become more comfortable speaking Mandarin in class, develop better concentration and learning habits, and

show a more positive attitude towards Mandarin study. Regular oral reading practice lays a strong foundation for their future listening, speaking and comprehension skills, supporting steady progress in Mandarin learning.





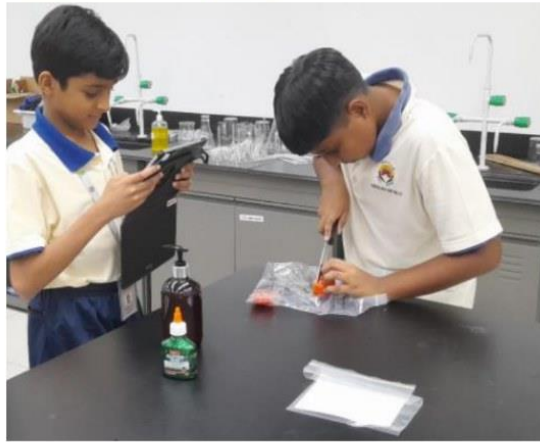


DNA Extraction from Fruits and Vegetables – STEM & INNOVATION CLUB

Have you ever wondered what DNA looks like? In our recent science activity, students explored the fascinating world of genetics by extracting DNA from everyday fruits and vegetables! Using simple materials such as detergent, salt, and alcohol, students were able to break open the cells and release the DNA hidden inside. Fruits like strawberries and bananas are especially suitable because they contain a high amount of DNA, making the results easier to observe. During the experiment, students mashed the fruit, added the extraction solution, and carefully poured alcohol to separate the DNA. Soon, white, thread-like strands appeared—this was the DNA! It was an exciting moment as students witnessed something usually invisible to the naked eye. This hands-on activity helped students understand cell structure, the role of DNA, and basic laboratory techniques. It also showed that science can be fun, interactive, and easily explored using materials found at home. Overall, the DNA extraction experiment sparked curiosity and encouraged students to think like young scientists, making learning both meaningful and enjoyable.
