Gardening Activity

Finally students must arrange the cloth clips according to the number written on the cloth clips and arrange them accordingly with the correct sequence.

Now students can arrange the numbers in the correct sequence and are able to recognize number 12. The students enjoyed these activities and the interaction between the students contributed significantly to their social and cognitive development.


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HTML HEADING / COLOR CODE TAGS
